

## YOUR VOTE IS YOUR VOICE - How to Vote in Bucks County

**Municipal Primary Election Day is May 16, 2017**

**Municipal Election Day is November 7, 2017**

### HOW TO CHECK TO SEE IF YOU ARE REGISTERED

Call the Board of Elections or check online to see if you are registered at: [Voter Registration Bucks County](#)

### HOW TO REGISTER TO VOTE

The last day to register for the primary is April 17, and for the Municipal Election, **October 10, 2017**. For information, go to [www.votesPA.com](#) or contact the Board of Elections, where you may be able to register online. If you are in the military or a US citizen living overseas, go to [www.fvap.gov/](#) for voting information.

### HOW TO FIND YOUR POLLING PLACE

Go to [www.votesPA.com](#), contact the Board of Elections, or go to [PA Voter Services](#).

### WHAT TO BRING ON ELECTION DAY

You are not required to provide ID unless you are a first time voter. For acceptable forms of ID go to [www.votesPA.com](#) or call the Board of Elections.

### HOW TO VOTE – In Person, by Provisional Ballot, Absentee Ballot or Alternative Ballot

You must vote in person at your assigned polling place while the polls are open. You may request a provisional ballot at your polling place if there is a question about your eligibility to vote at the polling place. If you meet specific criteria and are unable to vote at your polling place you may request an Absentee Ballot, Alternative Ballot, Emergency Absentee Ballot or Emergency Alternative Ballot. Call the Board of Elections or go online to [www.votesPA.com](#). **The last day to apply for an absentee ballot for the primary is May 9, and for the Municipal Election, October 31, 2017. The Board of Elections must receive**

**your absentee ballot for the primary by May 12, and for the Municipal Election, November 3, 2017 or your vote will not be counted.**
